Master Orff clinician Karen Medley will help us all to connect, play, and reflect on our strengths as an Orff Schulwerk community. This workshop will celebrate our potential for wonder and foster our capacity for resilience as we make joyful music together before returning home to share what we have learned with our students. Mini Conference participants will also benefit from the teaching expertise of Donna Knudson, Lucy Kay Osborne, Patricia Bourne, and Ann Palmason. Donna Knudson will be presenting "Volume 1 Made Easy." Lucy Kay will teach the basics of Orff instrument repair. Patty Bourne will lead the choral reading session on Saturday morning. Don't forget to indicate whether you will be attending this session on your registration form. And Ann Palmason's session will "Celebrate Syllables with the Instrumentarium." Participants will pick up skill-building activities for K-5 with a focus on the way syllables create rhythmic patterns. Bring a soprano recorder to investigate pieces by Isabel Carley. Clinician Biography:

Karen Medley is an elementary music specialist in the Pentucket Regional School District in northeastern Massachusetts. Formerly a teacher in the Clark County Schools, Las Vegas, Nevada, and a teacher in the Memphis City Schools, Tennessee, for over twenty years, she received a Bachelor of Music Education degree from the Eastman School of Music of the University of Rochester. She also studied at the University of Memphis, where she earned a Master of Music degree with a concentration in Orff Studies, and completed her Orff Teacher Training Levels I - III and Master Class. Karen served on the American Orff Schulwerk Association National Board of Trustees for more than 13 years as Regional Representative for two terms and also as National Conference Chairperson for the 1994, 1996, 2000, and 2007 AOSA National Conferences.

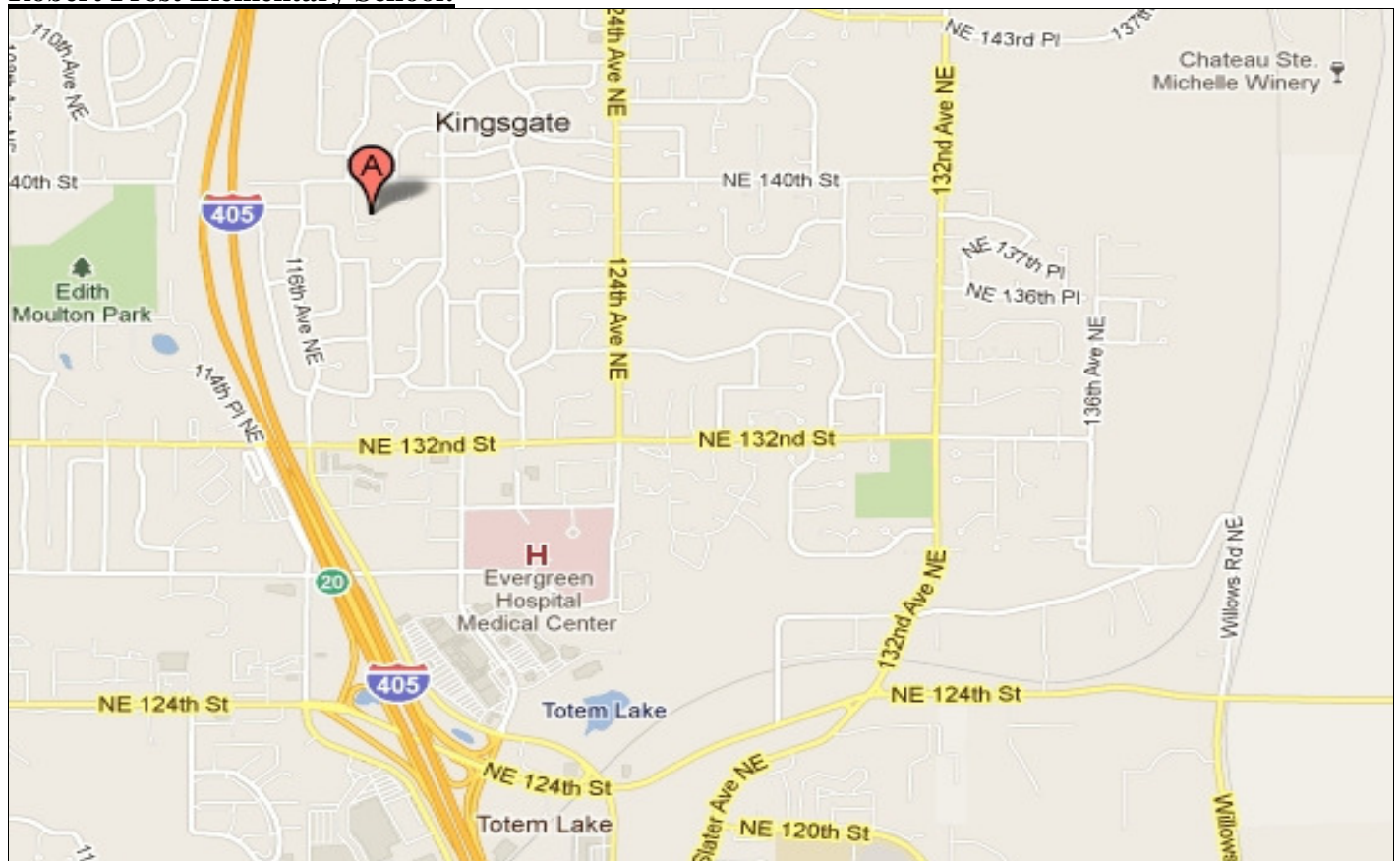
