Judy Brack will present two tried-and-true activities in creative expression and polyrhythms for the wide range of abilities in our classrooms and which can culminate in dynamic performance pieces. Listen to the Rain is a 3rd grade thematic unit in 3-part singing, instrumental accompaniment for all levels of ability, and expressive use of percussion to accompany a poem. The Fierce Creature, a reworking of the story Who is in Hare's House by Rene Boyer Alexander, offers 6th grade students an opportunity in dramatic expression through voice and instruments, and in building a polyrhythmic orchestra.

Stephanie Magnusson will present Middle Eastern style drumming, singing and dance. She will show how to use the instruments you already have in your room to expand the world music you incorporate into your teaching. Linda Swier will be presenting music from Japan, and Janis Salzer will be presenting a Make-N-Take on PVC Pipe Native American Flutes. Janis has done this activity at 5<sup>th</sup> grade outdoor camp for the past 8 years. The kids love it! If you are sensitive to sandpaper dust particles please bring a dust mask, protective eye wear and possibly a pair of gloves to protect your hands. Patty and Paul will present African marimbas. The workshop will end with a marimba ensemble jam session... not to be missed!

#### Directions to The Bush School:

##### *From The West, North or South...*

From I-5, take 520 east, exit Montlake, go straight at the stoplight at the end of the ramp and follow the road (which becomes Lake Washington Blvd) through the Arboretum. Go straight at the Madison intersection stoplight and proceed for one-half mile. Watch for school crosswalk (overhead sign) and take first right after that onto E. Harrison St. Bush parking garage is on the right after the field.

##### *From The East...*

From the east side, cross the lake on 520 and take the first exit on the Seattle side, Lake Washington Blvd. At the end of the ramp, turn left onto Lake Washington Blvd. and follow the road through the Arboretum. Go straight at the Madison intersection stoplight and proceed for one-half mile. Watch for school crosswalk and take first right after that onto E. Harrison St. Bush parking garage is on the right after the field.
