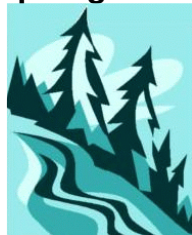

Help Evergreen Orff Chapter kick-off its 2000-2010 workshop year by attending September Sharing. EOC Scholarship recipient Stephanie Magnusson, and Bush School music specialist Mark Francis will present field tested lessons for students of all ages. Stephanie will be presenting lessons derived from activities done in her Master Class this summer with international Schulwerk pioneer Jos Wuytack. This will include improvisation activities, use of canon, theme and variations, and dance too! Mark will guide participants through classroom tested Orff process lessons using barred instruments, movement, and drama. Come out to sing, say, dance, play and reconnect with old friends and colleagues. College credit and 6 clock hours are available for attending this workshop. At our lunch hour we will also have our general membership meeting, so please plan on attending.

Mark Francis currently teaches Lower School music and choir at Seattle's Bush School. He earned his Master of Arts degree with a concentration in Orff Schulwerk from the University of St. Thomas in St. Paul, Minnesota. Mark has completed Level III Orff Schulwerk training, and currently serves on the AOSA History and Research committee. Mark presented past research at the 2008 AOSA National Conference in Charlotte, NC, and most recently was awarded a 2009 AOSA Research Grant for his work with the recorded legacy of Orff Schulwerk. Mark has been a workshop presenter for the Evergreen Orff Chapter, the Greater Cleveland AOSA Chapter and the University of Washington Information School.

Stephanie Magnusson is an elementary music specialist at Zeiger Elementary in the Puyallup School District. She has a Masters Degree in Music Education from Central Washington University and is a National Board Certified teacher, as well as a facilitator for National Board candidates. Stephanie completed her Introduction to Orff Schulwerk, and levels 1 and 2 through SPU, and level 3 in New York at Hofstra. She recently completed Master Class with Jos Wuytak in Memphis. She also has been approved as a recorder teacher through AOSA.

Directions to Hunt Elementary:

From the north:

Take to I-5 south and merge onto I-405 north via EXIT 154A on the LEFT toward RENTON. Merge onto WA-167 S via EXIT 2 toward KENT/AUBURN merge onto WA-512 W toward PUYALLUP/OLYMPIA. Take the exit toward SOUTH HILL/WA-161 S/EATONVILLE. Turn LEFT onto 104TH ST E/WA-161. Continue to follow WA-161. Turn LEFT onto 128TH ST E. 128TH ST E becomes RESERVOIR RD E. Turn RIGHT onto MILITARY RD E. Turn LEFT onto 122ND AVE E. Turn LEFT onto 144TH ST E.

End at 12801 144th St E Puyallup, WA 98374

From the south:

I-5 N toward SEATTLE Merge onto WA-512 E via EXIT 127 toward PUYALLUP. Take the WA-161 S exit toward EATONVILLE. Turn right onto 104TH ST E/WA-161. Continue to follow WA-161. Turn LEFT onto 128TH ST E. 128TH ST E becomes RESERVOIR RD E. Turn RIGHT onto MILITARY RD E. Turn LEFT onto 122ND AVE E. Turn LEFT onto 144TH ST E. The school is on the left side of the street.
